This year, Mike Bailey Paint Services has enjoyed a collaborative project working in busy Chapel Street's shopping precinct in South Yarra.

A contract from Builders – Bortolotto Services – property maintenance solutions, saw Mike Bailey Paint Group refurbishing 5 shops and façades including 565 Chapel Street, to create a fully rendered wall for Dulux. After preparing and painting the façades, Melbourne artist David Bromley was commissioned to apply his masterful brush.
